Mission Statement

To provide prospective commanding officers information and a course of instruction designed to enhance their performance as commanders. The course is issue focused and provides information on current USMC policies and programs, as well as addressing matters related to warfighting and readiness. It is conducted twice annually for a period of two weeks. The program includes a week long Spouses Workshop that is designed to provide the commanders' spouses information on the programs and support assets/resources available to them, as well as enhance the skills necessary to assist them in their role. The Spouses Workshop focuses on issues likely to arise in connection with command responsibilities and additionally provides information on maintaining the communication links between the command, families, community, and service providers.
